Dear Family Members,

I need to apologize for this morning message on visitation at the Sheyenne Care Center. The information received last night was different than the information received from our VP3 coordinator this afternoon. After our visit with the ND Health Department VP3 coordinator this afternoon, we were informed that due to having no residents with a positive COVID that we were able to continue with our phase 2 procedures on family's visitation. This means that Sheyenne Care Center will resume family visitation as scheduled tomorrow.

The two employees that were identified as positive COVID had no symptoms or signs of being sick. This has been my biggest fear is asymptomatic individuals who don't realize they are a carrier of this virus. We have been in continuous contact with them and have taken them off the schedule until they have recovered and/or we have two negative tests on each of them. Once this is achieved they will return to work as scheduled.

Again, I apologize for my message this morning and hopes that we can continue to keep everyone safe.
