We have increased monitoring of residents on 3rd floor and SCU and one resident on 2nd floor for precautionary measures.

Even though we were tested on the 7th of October the state Health Department scheduled us for another round of testing for today 10/12/2020. This is due to the overwhelming amount of testing taking place in the state of North Dakota and the state Lab is running at capacity.

The only way we continue to be a safe place at Sheyenne Care Center is by wearing our masks, goggles, and social distance along with hand sanitizing and washing hands frequently.
