Dear Families and Friends

I'm please to inform families that today's discussion was on how Sheyenne Care Center can continue to provide internal visitation in a safe manner for residents and families. Although our changes we are making with internal visitation is small it still provides more opportunity for resident and families to visit and remain safe during their visits.

Starting Saturday, October 24<sup>th</sup>, our internal visitation hours will expand to 9:00 am and end at 8:45 pm with an hour break for lunch and dinner. The guidelines will remain the same as before where visitation will occur in the library 7 days a week. One hour of visitation per family member per day and no one under 18 can schedule a meeting. Please come in the front door to be screened in and sign in identifying who you are visiting with. Also remember that you and your family member need to wear a mask at all time and sanitizes your hands before, during and after your visit. I can't stress how important it is to schedule 24 hours in advance and to be considerate about other families wanting to visit their loved one. With the limited time frames we have available at this time, please do not schedule back to back days of visitations.

As we continue to move through this pandemic we will continuously discuss how we can enhance visitation and bring families together in a safe manner.
